



Vision Screening Policy

Virtual Preparatory Academy of Oklahoma (the “School”) adopts this vision screenings policy to ensure compliance with Oklahoma law. Oklahoma law states, “The parent or guardian of each student enrolled in kindergarten, first, and third grades at a public school must provide proof that their student passed a vision screening within the last 12 months.” State law further states, “No student shall be prohibited from attending school for the lack of a vision screening certification or an eye examination report.” This policy shall provide notice to the guardian of students attending the School of these legal requirements.

The School will offer all students’ yearly vision screenings, with the consent of the legal guardian, free of charge or provide information about locations where free vision screenings can be obtained in the student’s local area. The legal guardian will continue to receive the results. The School will comply with any state reporting requirements. If guardians have questions, the School will designate a person to contact to address any questions.
